Course and credit requirements vary by program. Dual Degree students are required to take core curriculum courses through the Glenn College. ## Business Administration and Public Affairs (MPA/MBA)

To help students navigate the increasingly complex world of government-business relations, the John Glenn College of Public Affairs has joined with the [Fisher College of Business](#) to offer a Master of Public Administration and Master of Business Administration. Students who are enrolled in the MPA/MBA program full-time can earn both degrees in three academic years. If earned independently, these degrees would require four years of study.

With the changing roles of public and nonprofit organizations, there is a rising demand for managers and leaders with sound business skills to offer substantial insights and function as change agents to effectively manage resources in a nonprofit and public organization.
